A CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS AND HEALTH PAPERS REQUIRED ON OUT OF STATE HORSES

Directions: On Hwy. 70 East of Indianapolis, take the Exit #123 for Hwy. 3 North to New Castle and go approx. 8 miles into New Castle. (At the Exit off of Hwy. 70 is a "Flyin J" truck stop) Continue past businesses and head North out of town. The "Park" is just out of town on the left. Turning left, head up the big hill and the grounds are on the left.

If coming from the North on Hwy. #3, the park is on the west side of the highway before you get into town. If coming from either East or West on Hwy. #38, turn north at the intersection with Hwy. #3 and park is north of town. Turn left into park and up the hill to grounds.

If traveling from the North on I-69, turn east on US35 at Exit 45 and go to Hwy. 3. Then south on Hwy. 3 to grounds as in above paragraph.
